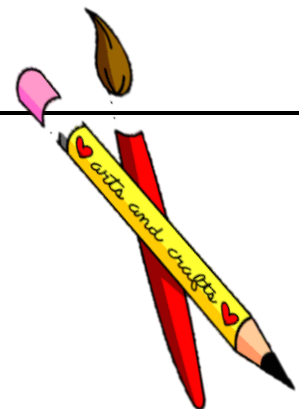

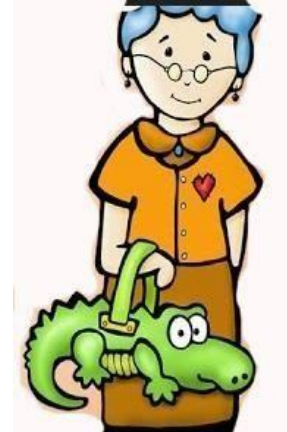
### 3. TINY TIM

They hold up their heads and look at the sun.



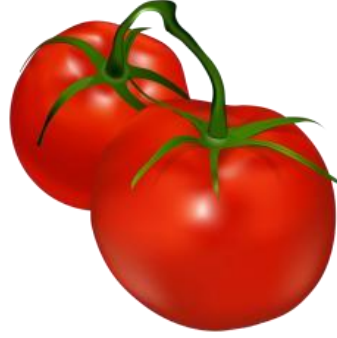
